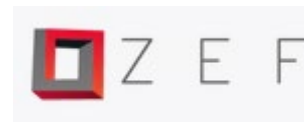

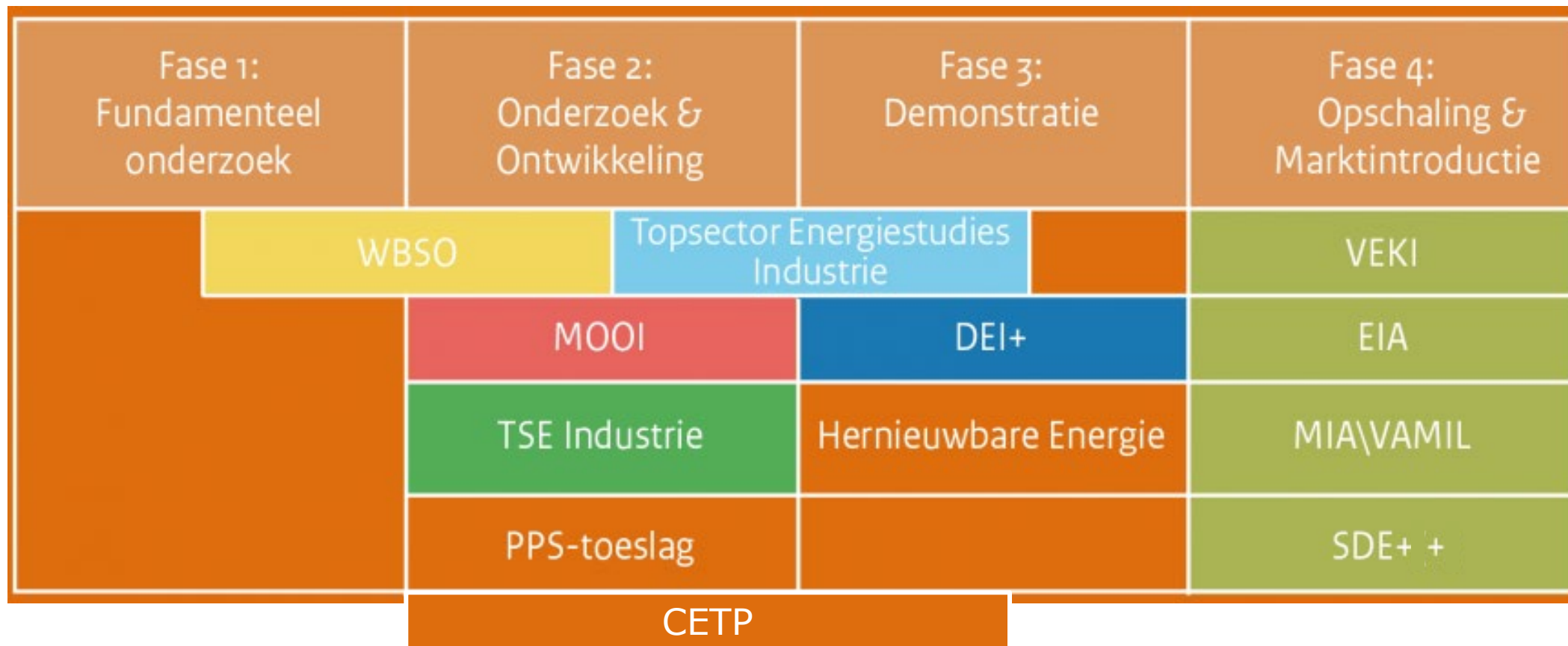


AVR 100ktpa capture plant





We have schemes, supporting different phases





We have schemes, supporting different phases

> TSE industry studies

- Subsidies for feasibility studies prior to pilot or demo projects
- Predominantly desk study work
- Max project time, 1 year
- Max subsidy, 2mln EUR
- First come first served; opened up until april '24

> TSE industry R&D

- R&D (Industrial Research, Experimental Development)
- Max project time, 4 years
- Max subsidy, 500k EUR
- Next opening expected in the spring
- Competitive tender, opened only for a month



We have schemes, supporting different phases

> DEI+



- Support for pilots and demonstration plants
- Pilots (=R&D) opened for all (CCUS) topics
- Demonstration only for topics included in the EU GBER
- Broadening of the EU GBER in supporting demo for capture and transport of CO2 and some CDR technologies
- Currently closed, expected to open again end of year
- Max project time, 4 years
- Max budget, 15mln EUR
- Budget allocation: First come first served

> MOOI

- R&D in large consortia tackling system wide knowledge gaps
- New opening in spring 2024, set up is under discussion
- Previously: max budget 4mln EUR, max project time 4 years
- Budget allocation: competitive tender in 2 phases



We have schemes, supporting different phases

- › CETP  
 - R&D in international consortia
 - We have had one successful year of participation in 2022
 - For the 2023 call:
 - Module 4, CCUS, includes CCS/U/R
 - RVO will not have dedicated funds for this, BUT
 - Application through **DEI+ or HER+ is possible**, AND
- **NWO will have dedicated budget** for Module 4 (and 8 and 9), aimed at participation from Universities, [more info here](#)
