





# We have schemes, supporting different phases





# We have schemes, supporting different phases

- › TSE industry studies 
  - Feasibility studies prior to pilot or demo projects
  - Predominantly desk study work
  - New round from 1 May, budget: 26,4mln EUR
  - Max project time, 1 year or 2 years (>1mln subsidy)
  - Max subsidy, 4mln EUR
  - First come first served; opened until april 2025

- › EKOO (TSE industry R&D) 
  - R&D (Industrial Research, Experimental Development)
    - CO2 capture and utilisation
  - Max project time, 4 years
  - Max subsidy per project: 500k EUR
  - 1 april – 14 mei, budget: 3 mln EUR
  - Competitive tender, opened for a short time (!)



# We have schemes, supporting different phases

## > DEI+

- Support for pilots and demonstration plants
- Pilots (=R&D) and demonstrations (environmental investment) opened for all CCUS topics
- Max project time, 4 years
- Max budget, 30mIn (demo) and 25mIn EUR (pilot)
- Opened up to the end of August
- Available budget 141mIn EUR
- Budget allocation: First come first served,

## > MOOI

- R&D in large consortia tackling system wide knowledge gaps
- CCUS topics: conversion of CO and CO2
- Max budget 4mIn EUR, max duration 4 years
- Budget allocation: competitive tender in 2 phases
  - First phase: 19 March – 18 April
  - Second phase: 4 June – 5 September
- Available budget 20,35 mIn EUR



# We have schemes, supporting different phases

- > CETP  
  - R&D in international consortia
  - Anticipate to participate with 2 mln EUR (Dutch) budget in 2024
  - Call text will be published **beginning of June**; all CCUS topics are included
  - Preproposals to be submitted from **mid September**
