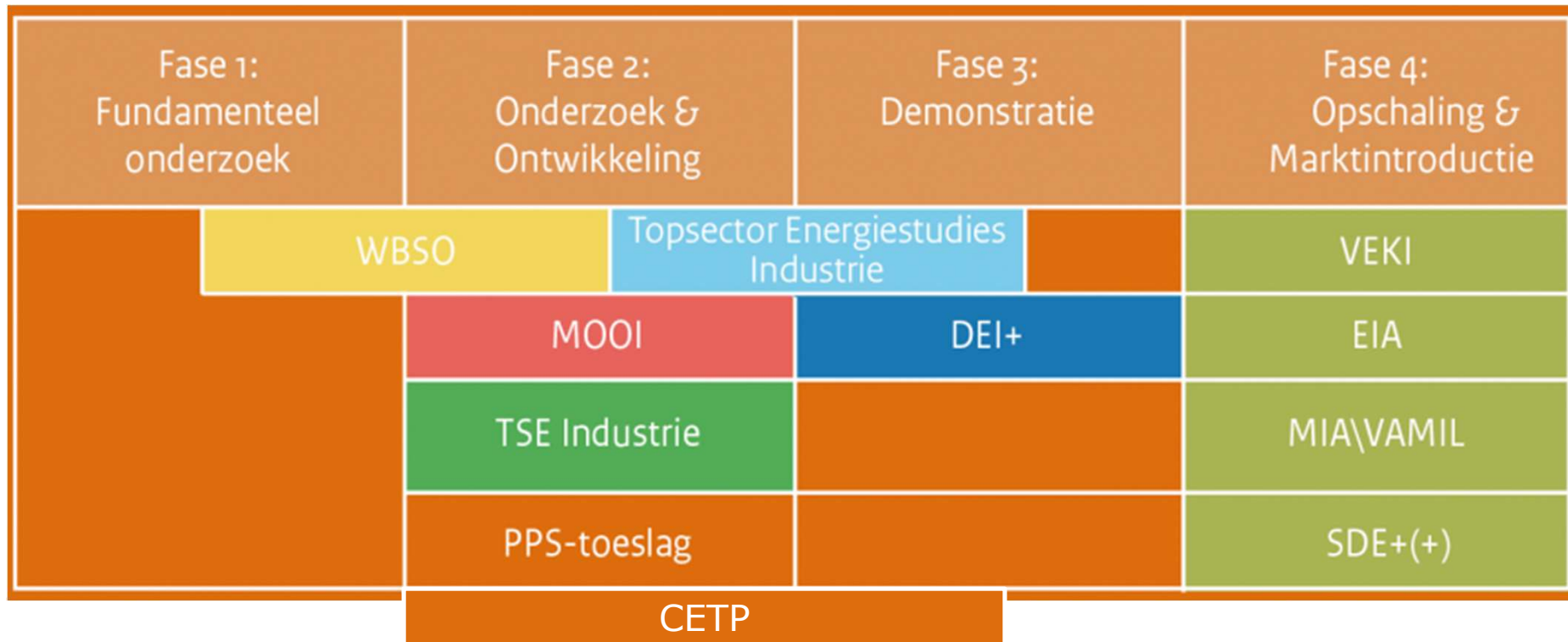

We have schemes, supporting different phases

> TSE industry studies

- Feasibility studies prior to pilot or demo projects
- Predominantly desk study work
- First come first serve (FCFS)
- Total budget: 26,4 mln EUR
- Max project time: 1 year or 2 years (>1mln subsidy)
- Max subsidy: 4 mln EUR
- **Current round open until april 2024, 100% of budget in evaluation, close to exhaustion**
- **New round expected Q2 2025**

> EKKO (TSE industry R&D)

- R&D (Industrial Research, Experimental Development)
 - EKKO Industrie: MMIP 6, 7, 8
- Max project time: 4 years
- Total budget: 3 mln EUR
- Competitive tender: opened for a short time (!)
- **Currently closed, open from April 1 to May 6, 2025**



We have schemes, supporting different phases

> DEI+

- Support for pilots and demonstration plants
- Pilots (=R&D) and demonstrations (environmental investment) opened for all CCS/CCU/CDR topics
- Max project time: 4 years
- Max budget: 30mIn (demo) and 25mIn EUR (pilot)
- Budget allocation: First come first served
- Projects aimed at CO2 for greenhouses are excluded
- Demonstration support is not available for all technologies

- **Open: January 28 to August 28, 2025**

> MOOI

- R&D in large consortia tackling system wide knowledge gaps
- CCUS topics: conversion of CO and CO2
- Max budget 4mIn EUR, max duration 4 years
- Budget allocation: competitive tender in 2 phases
- **Currently closed for Industry / CCUS topics, expected to be opened Q2 2026**



We have schemes, supporting different phases

> CETP


- R&D in international consortia
- NL participates in CCS with 2 mln EUR (Dutch) budget in 2024
- All CCUS topics are included
- **Joint call 2024 deadline for full proposals for eligible projects: April 2, 2025**
- **New call is expected in 2025, more information will follow**

> TKI E&I PPS toeslag

- R&D projects with companies and knowledge institutions
- Total budget: 4,5 mln EUR
- Project budget: 0,25 – 2 mln EUR
- Theme: "Nieuwe ketens voor koolstofchemie"
- **Open: March 5 to April 15, 2025**
